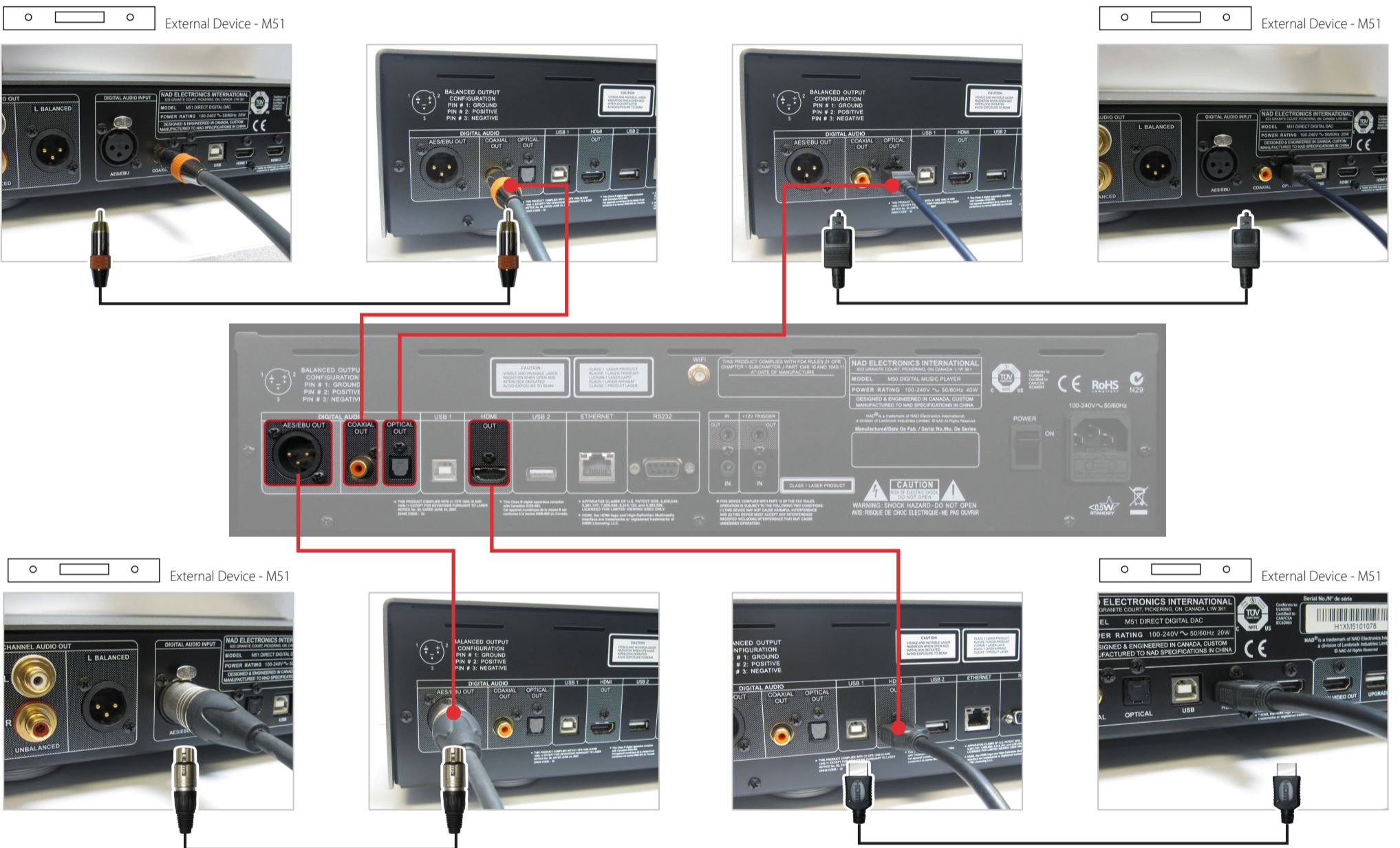


IMPORTANT!

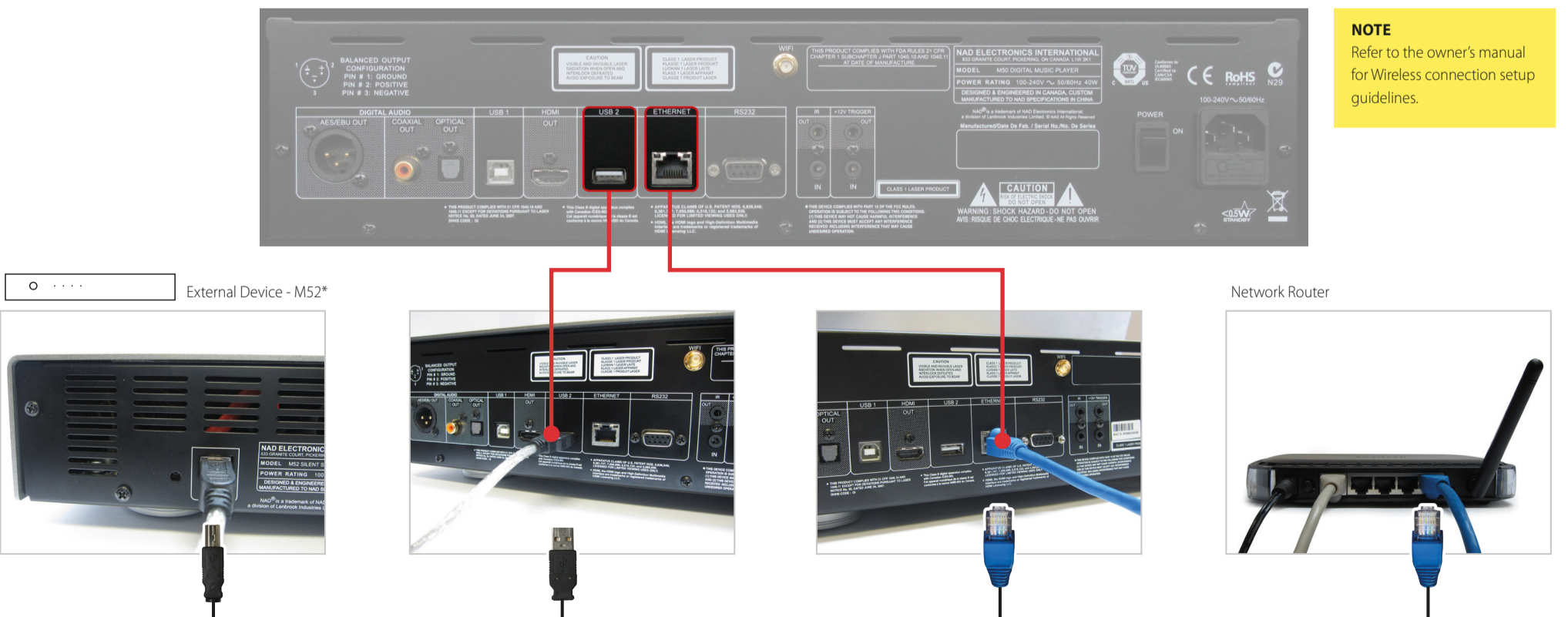

For Android devices, download the free NAD BluOS Controller App on Google Play.

CONNECT TO MUSIC

You're ready to stream Internet Radio!



- Go to the Music Sources menu by tapping the **Home** menu icon.



- Launch **TuneIn** and select your favorite radio station from anywhere on the planet. Live!

To play music stored on a computer or NAS device,



- Select the Settings icon on the upper right corner of your device's display screen.
- Choose "Configure Player" from the pop-up menu, and then "Configure Network Shares".
- Follow the screen prompts, and open your whole home to the pleasure of streaming HiFi music.

Note: For first time use, be sure to initiate "Upgrade now" when a "Player notification" window pops up. This will update your NAD M50 with the latest software available.

M50 AS A STAND-ALONE CD PLAYER
